1. Narrative/Overview Narrative By Jesse Windham

On June 25th, 2022 at approximately 0150 hours I, Deputy Windham, observed a male approach myself and two other deputies in front of the east office. The male had blood shot watery eyes and stumbled several times while walking. The male asked to be arrested for public intoxicated and stated that he was drunk. While he spoke I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath. The male was told several times to return to his home which was across the street and he refused to do so. Eventually he was placed under arrest and transported to Jennie Edmundson Hospital after he requested a chemical test at his own expense. After the sample was taken by the medical staff and confirmed to be a good sample, he was transported to the Pottawattamie County Jail.
