1. Narrative/Overview Narrative By Jesse Windham

On July 1st, 2022 at approximately 2220 hours I, Deputy Windham, was working off-duty at Harrah's Stir Cove when I observed a security guard attempting to escort a female out of the concert. The female was not cooperating and

refused to walk out, stopping at a beer stand and grabbing hold of it. I then assisted the security guard in escorting her out when the females daughter pushed him and said "that's my mom, she didn't do anything" the security guard then turned toward the daughter and started pushing her toward the exit as well. The mother then turned on the security guard and yelled "that's my daughter" before jumping on his back and striking him in the back of the head with her right hand. I then pulled the mother off of the security guard and detained her before detaining her daughter as well.

The security guard who was struck in the head stated that he wanted to press charges and the mother was placed under arrest and transported to the Pottawattamie County Jail.
