1. Narrative/Overview Narrative By Marc Freeman

Suspicious Acitivity / Possible Burglary to vehicle

On September 6th, 2022, at approx 1502hrs Deputies from the Pottawattamie County Sheriff's Office were called to the 60 mile marker of Interstate 29 southbound for a vehicle on the side of the road and a male reportedly going through the vehicle. The caller to 911 thought this activity might be a little suspicious. Once deputies were dispatched to this call the response time was only approx 5-10min.

Upon arriving on scene with Pottawattamie County Conservation law enforcement officer a male subject was located entering the car and going through it. Male was found to have no ownership or right to the car or its belongings. This male was arrested and a full investigation was completed on this case.
